MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION AT SCHOOL

By Oregon law, if medication must be given at school, the following must occur:

- Provide written permission (forms are available at school). Any change to the medication will require the parent to update the medication form at the time of change.
- Make sure all medication (prescription and over-the-counter), this includes cough drops, is in its original container and marked with the student's name.
- **All medication must be delivered to school by the parent or responsible adult designated by the parent.** Students may **not** keep medications with them.
- Make sure the school has an adequate supply of all medications required by your child.
- Pick up the medication when it is no longer needed at school. **All medication not picked up by the end of the year will be destroyed.**
